1. All exhibits must consist of exactly the number of specimens or varieties indicated or they will be disqualified. The same specimens may not be entered as both individual fruits and as part of a collection.
2. In Section B, exhibitors may enter only one plate of each variety, but may exhibit up to 3 varieties in any one lot. Please specify varieties of all individual plates on entry form.
3. Collections will be judged on the following:

Attractiveness of Arrangement	35 points
Quality of Fruit	35 points
Number of Varieties of Fruit	30 points

SECTION A - FRUIT COLLECTIONS

1. Fruit Collection - 5 or more different fruits. Different varieties of the same fruit may be included in the exhibit but will count as only one of the five required fruits.
2. Apple Collection - 5 specimens each of 4 or more different varieties of apples.
3. Grape Collection - 3 bunches each of 4 or more different varieties of grapes.
4. Berry Collection - 1 pint each of 3 or more different berries.
5. Collection of any other fruit - 5 specimens each of 4 or more different varieties of any one fruit not listed above.
