

# CLASS 1 - J

## JUNIOR FRUITS & VEGETABLES



1. All exhibits must consist of exactly the number of specimens or varieties indicated. Exhibits containing less than (or more than) the required number will be disqualified. The same specimen may not be entered as both an individual fruit/vegetable and as part of a collection.
2. All vegetables should be in prime market condition. The quality of a vegetable does not necessarily depend on its size.
3. In Section A, collections will be judged on the following: Attractiveness of Arrangement (35 points); Quality of Items (35 points); and Number of Varieties included (30 points).
4. In Sections C and D, exhibitors may enter only one plate of each variety, but may exhibit up to 3 varieties in any one lot. Please specify all varieties of all individual plates on entry form.
5. Lots that have fewer than 3 entries may be combined with other lots of a similar nature at superintendent's discretion.

### SECTION A – VEGETABLE COLLECTIONS

#### LOT

1. **Vegetable Collection** (variety) - 4 or more different vegetables all by the same exhibitor. Different varieties of the same vegetable may be included in the exhibit but will count as only one of the four required vegetables.
2. **Vegetable Collection** (single) – 3 specimens each of 3 or more different varieties of a single vegetable type all by the same exhibitor (e.g., Tomato collection could be: 3 yellow pear tomatoes, 3 beefsteak tomatoes and 3 Roma tomatoes). All sizes and varieties included.
3. **Herb Collection** - One small bouquet each of 3 or more different herbs, fresh or dried. Each herb must be labeled.
